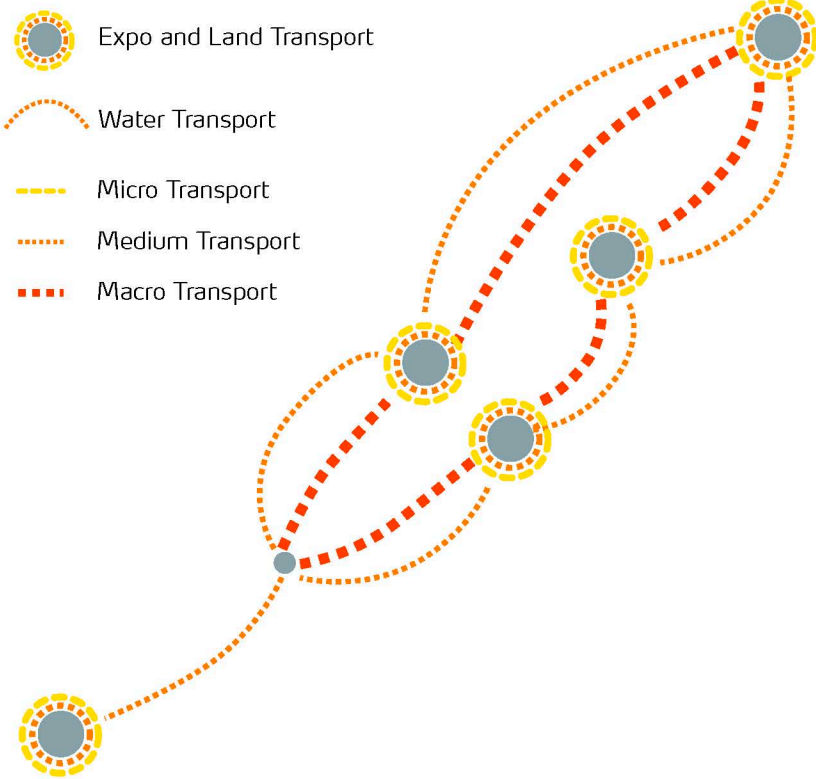


NYC 6th BORO | BLUE NETWORK WATER as liquid state of EARTH

WATER as a liquid state of EARTH, is assumed as a proposal that integrates the surface of the water that surrounds NYC as an occupied territory, in extension with the shore. Thus from a flexible, sustainable and self sufficient structure, which composes the expo program: Clean Tech Expo, five functional clusters are defined linked by a mobility network that is organized in three levels: a Macro level, Medium level and a Micro level. The Macro level includes five mobility units associated with the exhibition and features themes related to each of five boroughs:

- Walking – Manhattan
- Agriculture – Queens,
- Transformation – Staten Island,
- Energy – Brooklyn and
- Roading – Bronx.

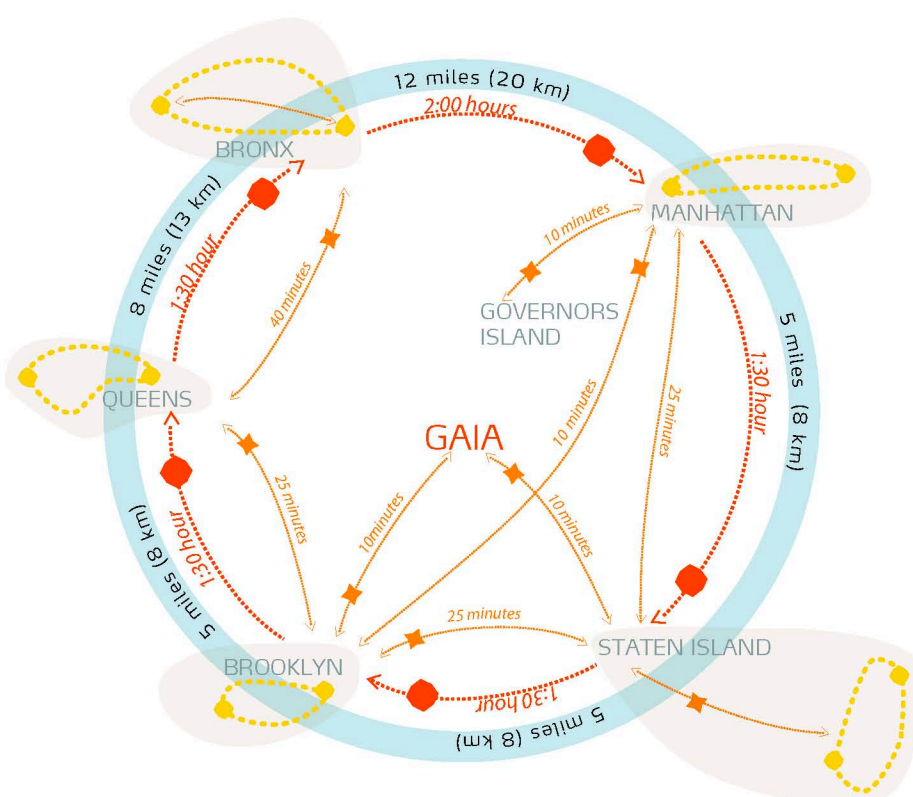
The medium level integrates collective transport units and the micro level private transport units. The transport network links the various dimensions of the proposal in a vast territory that takes land and water as common elements in the same urban reality – the 6th Boro.



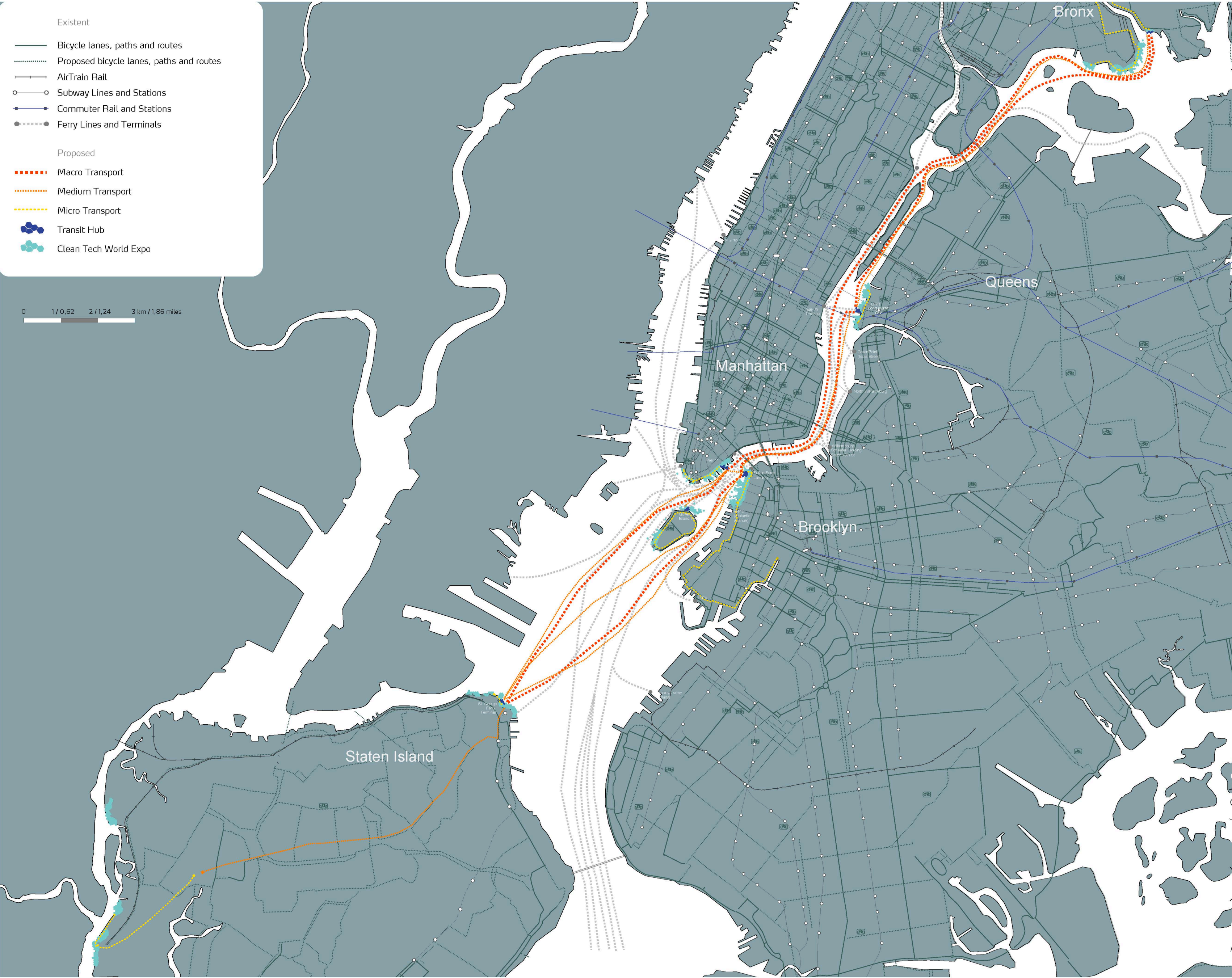
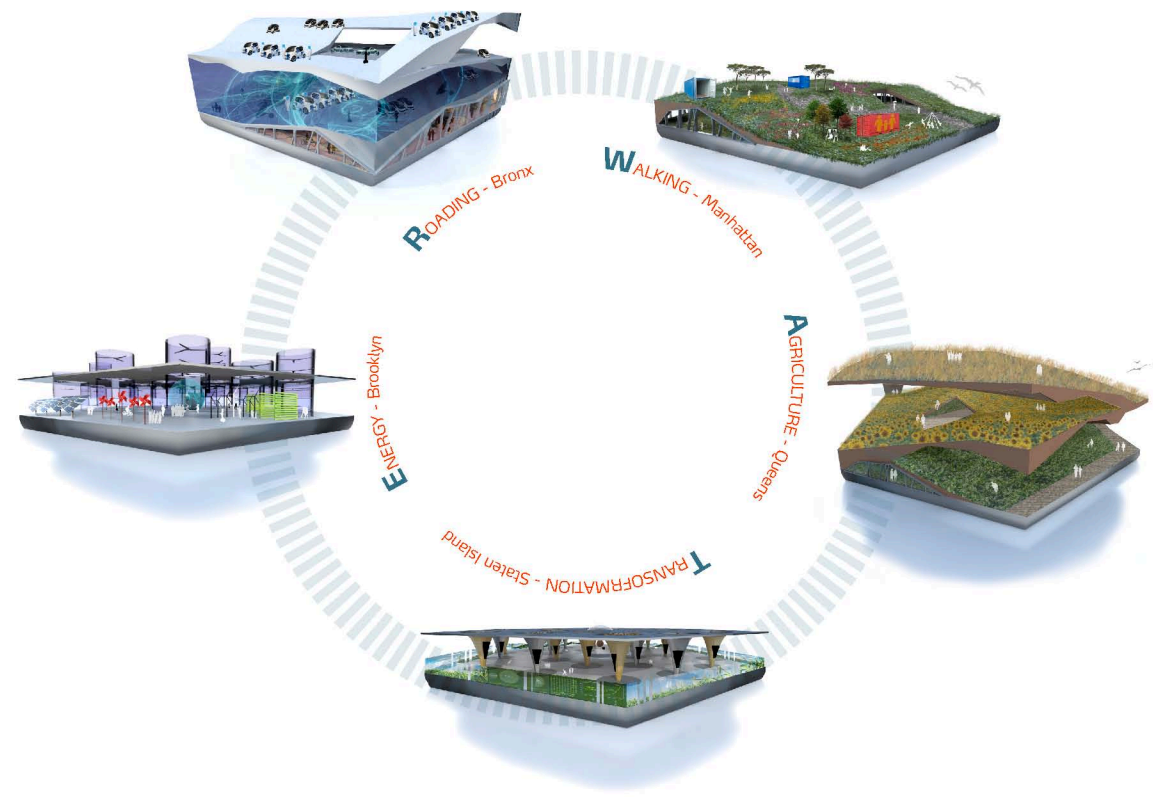
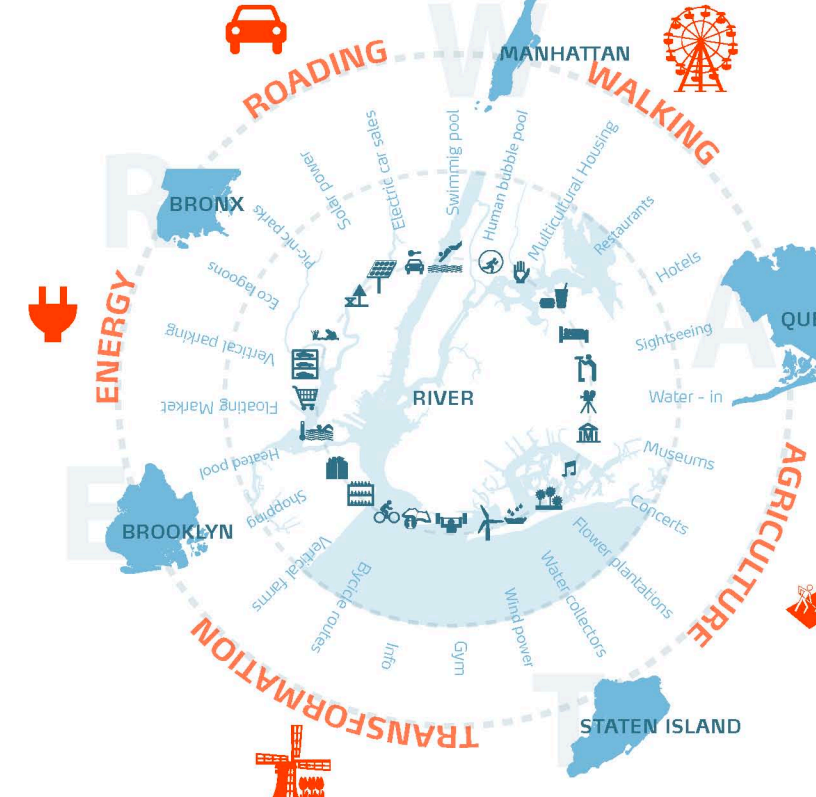

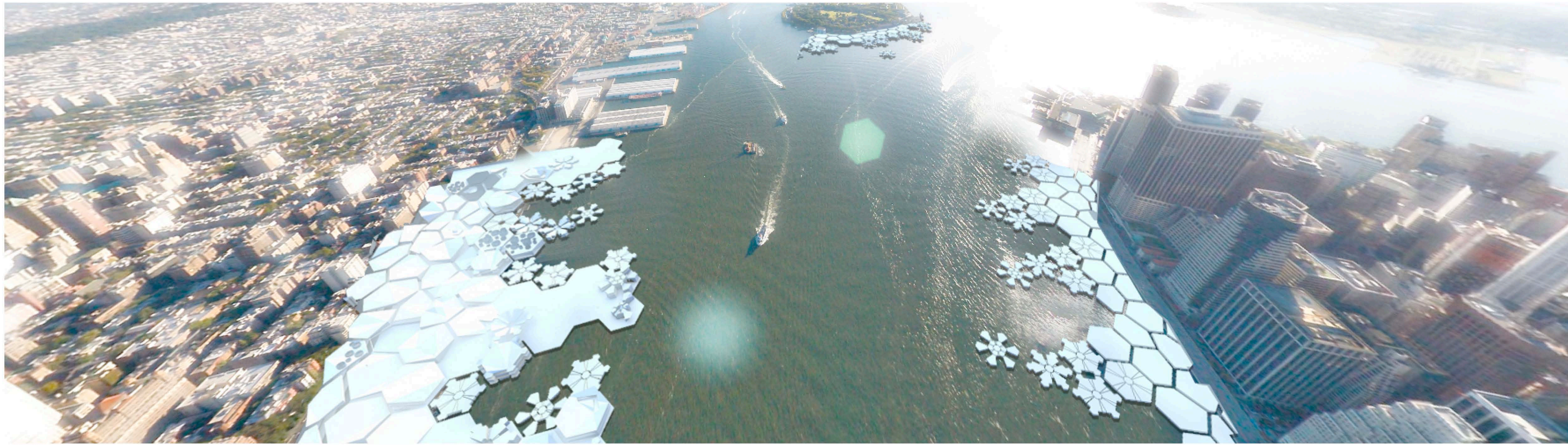
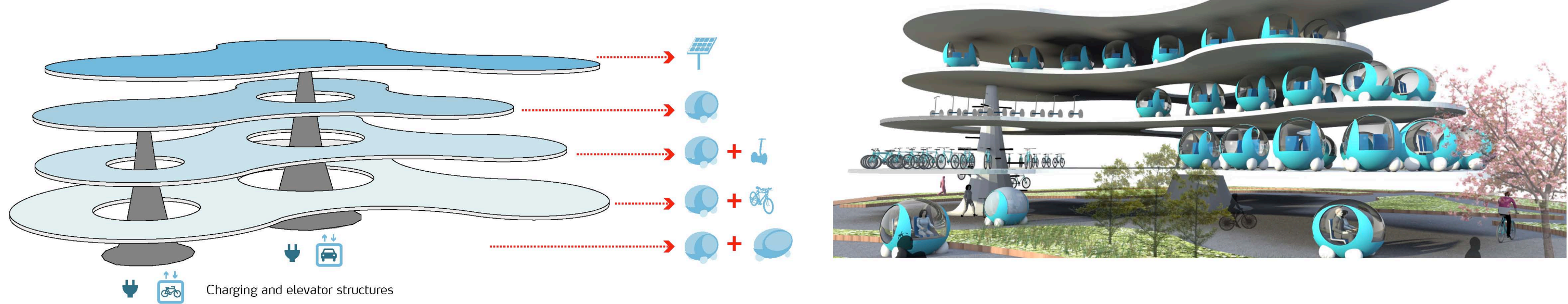
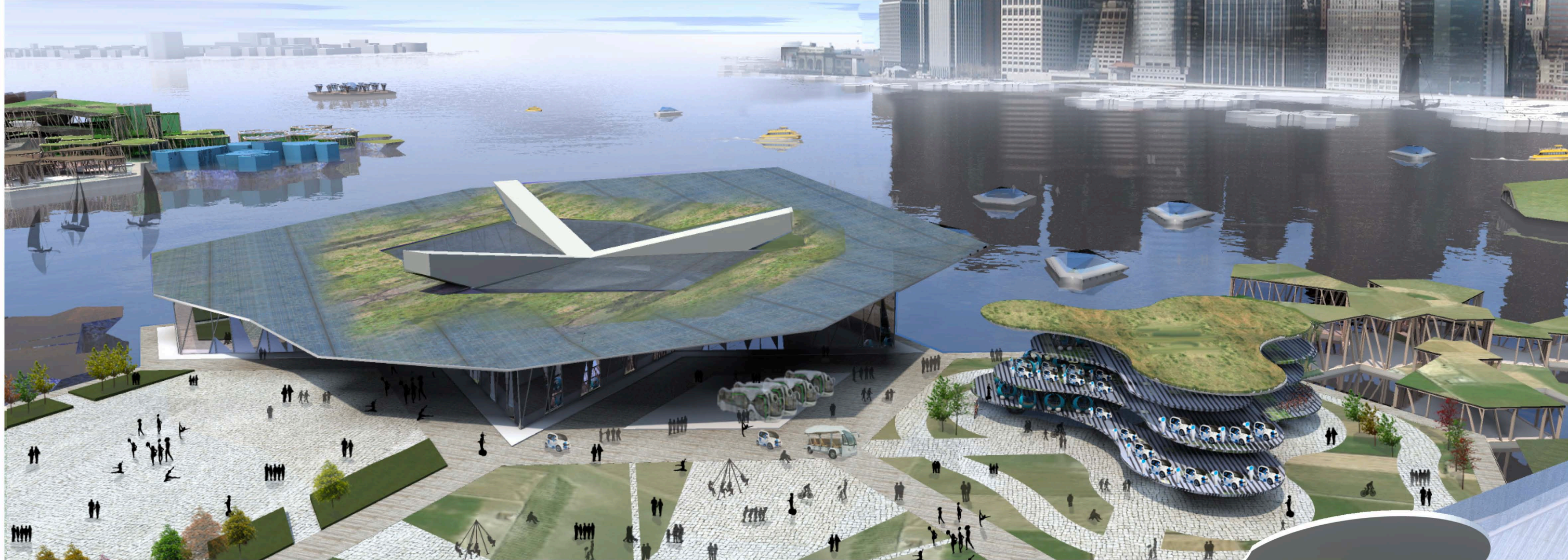
NYC Blue Network system
